

NSWISA Aussie Skate **Progressive Point Score System**



The progressive point score system will commence at the first Aussie Skate competition after NSW Championships and points will accumulate over the Aussie Skate competition year. It is an annual point score, with all scores being reset to zero at the commencement of the next Aussie Skate competition year.

The point system is organised in such a way that all skaters will be encouraged to compete and will be rewarded for doing so. Competitive spirit is important, and thus the majority of points will be gained from competing. Those skaters who place will be given 1, 2 or 3 bonus points to add to their points gained from participating.

Points will be allocated as follows:

First Place:	8 points
Second Place:	7 points
Third Place:	6 points
Competitor:	5 points

There will be three separate divisions in the point score:

- Division 1: Tots through to Stroking;
- Division 2: Freestyle, Edges, Dance and Shadow;
- Division 3: Synchronised.

If a skater commences the year in Division 1, and then moves to Division 2, their points will be transferred to the Division 2 tally. The Division 3 tally will be entirely separate to the other divisions and competitors may be earning points in Divisions 1 and 3 or 2 and 3.

At the end of each year a trophy/trophies will be awarded to the skater(s) who have accumulated the most points in each division.

The Annual Club Point Score Trophy will be awarded to the club with the most points gained by their skaters during the Aussie Skate Year.
