## REQUIREMENTS/INFORMATION

- \* Competitors must enter the competition at the level in which they intend to skate in the NSW Championships.
- \* All competitors **MUST** hold current financial membership with NSWISA **and** an affiliated club.
- \* Individual trophies or medals will be given as placed.
- \* Synchronized Junior, Senior & Adult teams will only skate the short program they will skate at NSW States championships
- \* Home club member is defined as a current membership holder and representative of Penrith Valley Figure Skating Club
- \* The organising committee and referee of the 2008 Penrith Ice Palace Trophy decisions will remain final in all matters of the event.

- All competitors must abide by the published rules, eligibility criteria and requirements of this event.
- All Competitors must submit their PPC with their entry form. Entries will not be accepted without it.
- Test level is at date of close of entries.

**Marking:** I J S marking will be used

**Music:** Programs will be skated to music of the skater's choice. Vocal music with lyrics is not permitted. Music **MUST** be on a CD. All CDs **MUST** be clearly marked with the competitor's name, event and music time. The official competition CD must be submitted at the Registration Desk at the time of registration. CDs **MUST** have one piece of music per CD. Please have a spare copy at the rink during the event in case it is needed. Music may be retrieved from the Registration Desk after the event.

**Schedule of Events:**

Short programs will be skated on the 26<sup>th</sup> April 2008 and the Free Skating Programs will Be skated on the 27<sup>th</sup> April 2008. Single event divisions will not be scheduled until after the closing date.

**Trophies:** Trophies or medals will be issued to each place 1<sup>st</sup> 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup>.

**Video Recording:** Forms will be required to be completed on the day & video passes will be issued at no charge. Videoing can only be done in the designated area.
