

## NSWISA Position Description – Selection

---

The role of the Selection Convenor is to be responsible for any selection requirements or information requests put to the Association.

### **Desirable Attributes:**

The Selection Convenor should:

- be a person who has an intimate understanding of the sport and its participants
- have the ability to logically assess candidates against criteria
- be confident in drafting references and responses

### **Specific duties include but are not limited to:**

- Review and make recommendations or decide on outcomes regarding the selection of Members for items such as grants, awards, representation & scholarships
- Respond to requests for information or recommendations from external parties such as universities, government bodies, the Olympic Council, etc.
- Review and ensure the correctness of the NSW Team for interstate events
- Decide on the bestowing of various recognitions such as awards
- Nominate Members for Life Membership
- Maintain ethical standards in the selection process
