| Eligibility to Compete | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Previous winners of NSWISA Aussie Skate divisions may not re-enter the division won except where there were less than 3 entrants in that division but may enter a higher division even though they may not have yet passed the necessary test level. Skaters may not enter a division lower than that for which they have passed the test. For divisions split by age the grouping is determined by the age reached by July 1 preceding the competition. Care must be taken that all competitors are entered in the correct divisions, as changes may not be allowed due to scheduling. |
| Practice Sessions | There will be no official practices provided at this event. |
| Skater Registration | Competitors must register <u>at least ½ hour</u> prior to their scheduled event. |

| Withdrawals | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Register your withdrawal using this link, you will be required to upload a medical certificate if the withdrawal occurs before the draw and a refund is required • Refund only with a medical certificate provided before the draw • A 25% administration fee to cover costs will be deducted from the refund • Transaction Fees will not be refunded • No refund permitted after the draw • The Music upload fees, and any late fees will not be refunded in case of withdrawal |

| Music Provision | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Music submitted for full ice divisions as per the NSWISA Music & PPC Submission Policy • All divisions requiring music will submit a copy of their music electronically via the competition registration platform according to the NSWISA Music & PPC Submission Policy • If not received by close of entries, the entry will be considered incomplete • Music can be resubmitted after the closing date until the Friday 1 week before date of competition at no cost however, Music submitted after this will incur an additional \$25 per file to cover administration costs. They may ONLY photograph the skater that has been authorized on the registration form.</p> <p>Anyone caught photographing a skater without permission will be required to delete the images immediately when requested to do so by a competition official.</p> <p>No flash photography is permitted in warm-ups or events, as it may be dangerous to the skaters.</p> | <p>Individuals recording video will be required to register at the Information/Registration desk on the day of the event. They may ONLY video the skater that has been authorized on the registration form.</p> <p>Videeing can only be undertaken in the designated area.</p> <p>Anyone caught recording a skater without permission will be required to delete the footage immediately when requested to do so by a competition official.</p> <p>VIDEOING OF WARM-UPS IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED.</p> <p>No lights on cameras are permitted while videeing.</p> |
