Coaches	As per NSWISA_M_01 NSWISA Membership & Guest Registration Categories 2025 - NSW Coaches who wish to attend events held in NSW in the capacity of a coach will be required to have NSW Judging & Officials/Coaches Membership, Active Skater Membership, ISA Testing Membership or Life Membership. They will also be required to complete the NSWISA Coach Registration Form - Interstate/International coaches must complete Coaches Interstate or Coaches International registration Please see NSWISA Information for Coaches for further details
Eligibility to Compete	- Previous winners of NSWISA Aussie Skate divisions may not re-enter the division won except where there were less than 3 entrants in that division but may enter a higher division even though they may not have yet passed the necessary test level. - Skaters may not enter a division lower than that for which they have passed the test. - For divisions split by age the grouping is determined by the age reached by July 1 preceding the competition. - Care must be taken that all competitors are entered in the correct divisions, as changes may not be allowed due to scheduling.
Practice Sessions	There will be no official practices provided at this event.
Skater Registration	Competitors must register <u>at least 1 hour</u> prior to their scheduled event.

Entry Conditions, Payment Process and Eligibility to Compete	Entries will not be considered complete unless accompanied by: • All competitor details • Full payment on entry • Music submitted as per NSWISA Music & PPC Submission Policy (where applicable) • LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED (as per the NSWISA Entry to Competitions & Championships Policy)
Schedule	A schedule of events will be provided following the close of entries and published on the NSWISA website www.nswisa.com .
Withdrawals & Refund Policy	Withdrawals must be submitted through the official withdrawal form. Refunds: • Require a medical certificate submitted before the draw • Will incur a 25% administration fee • Will not include refunded transaction fees No refunds will be issued after the draw has been released. Late Music/PPC fees are non-refundable.
Awards / Trophies	Trophies/Medals will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd places in each division.
Music Provision	• Music submitted for full ice divisions as per the NSWISA Music & PPC Submission Policy • All divisions requiring music will submit a copy of their music electronically via the competition registration platform according to the NSWISA Music & PPC Submission Policy • If not received by close of entries, the entry will be considered incomplete • Music can be resubmitted after the closing date until the Friday 1 week before date of competition at no cost however, Music submitted after this will incur an additional \$25 per file to cover administration costs. Other Music File Notes	All competitors requiring music must have on hand at the event, a backup copy of their competition music on USB or phone. Music (ISU Rule 343 Singles, Pairs & Dance and ISU Rule 823 SYS): Please note paragraphs 1a), 1b), 1c), 2, 3, 4, re: Music Reproduction. Each program must be recorded on a separate file and labelled with competitor division, name and running time of the music. The electronic playlist will be deleted at the end of competition. All music remains the property of the skater and will not be shared or re-used.

OFFICIAL EVENT PHOTOGRAPHY/VIDEOGRAPHY	
Photography	Videography
An official photographer will be taking photos at the competition. Photos will be available for viewing and purchase. All private photographers are required to register at the Information/Registration Desk on the day of the event. They may ONLY photograph the skater that has been authorized on the registration form. Anyone caught photographing a skater without permission will be required to delete the images immediately when requested to do so by a competition official. No flash photography is permitted in warm-ups or events, as it may be dangerous to the skaters.	Individuals recording video will be required to register at the Information/Registration desk on the day of the event. They may ONLY video the skater that has been authorized on the registration form. Videoring can only be undertaken in the designated area. Anyone caught recording a skater without permission will be required to delete the footage immediately when requested to do so by a competition official. VIDEOING OF WARM-UPS IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED. No lights on cameras are permitted while videoing.
