ENTRY DETAILS

Eligibility & Membership Requirements	At the close of entries, all competitors must: • Be a full financial member of their Home Club • Be a current member of NSWISA or another State Association (ISA Member) • Hold valid membership for the entire competition period • Overseas competitors must be members of their national ISU-affiliated organisation where required. • Skaters must have passed the relevant ISA test level by close of entries. <i>Due to strictly limited ice time, entries will be accepted on a first-in basis, with preference given to MISC home club members. Late entries will not be accepted.</i>
Entry Requirements	Entries will only be accepted via the NSWISA online entry system. Entries will not be considered complete unless the following have been submitted: Full competitor details • Full payment at time of entry • Music upload (where applicable) • Planned Program Content (PPC) upload

Judging System & Technical Requirements	The competition will operate under current: • ISU Special Regulations and Technical Rules • ISU Communications • ISA Regulations and Communications The ISA Bonuses Policy will apply where relevant. The ISU Judging System (IJS) will be used for all IJS divisions. Results displayed during the competition remain provisional until officially certified by the Segment Referee and Technical Controller.
PPC	PPC submission forms are included as part of the online competition entry process. If PPCs are not received by the close of entries, the entry will be considered incomplete. PPCs may be updated free of charge until the Friday one week prior to competition. Late PPC resubmissions after this date will incur a \$25 administration fee per file.link
Music Provision	As per the NSWISA Music & PPC Submission Policy: • All competitors will submit a copy of their music electronically via the competition registration platform as per the NSWISA Music & PPC Submission Policy • If not received by close of entries, the entry will be considered incomplete • Music can be resubmitted up until the draw at no cost however, Music submitted after this will incur an additional \$25 per file to cover administration costs • Music resubmissions must be submitted via the online entry system using this link • All files must be submitted in the following format: MP3 • Please refer to document: ISA Music Provision Protocol

Other Music File Notes	All competitors requiring music must have on hand at the event, a backup copy of their competition music on USB or phone. Music (ISU Rule 343 Singles, Pairs & Dance and ISU Rule 823 SYS): Please note paragraphs 1a), 1b), 1c), 2, 3, 4, re: Music Reproduction. Each program must be recorded on a separate file and labelled with competitor division, name and running time of the music.
Withdrawals & Refund Policy	Withdrawals must be submitted through the official withdrawal form . Refunds: • Require a medical certificate submitted before the draw • Will incur a 30% administration fee • Will not include refunded transaction fees No refunds will be issued after the draw has been released. Late Music/PPC fees are non-refundable.
Practice Sessions	There will be no official practices provided at this event.

Skater Registration	Competitors must register <u>at least 1 hour</u> prior to their scheduled event.
Awards / Trophies	Trophies/Medals will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd places in each division.
