WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO APPLY?

ATHLETES MUST:

- Be a permanent resident of NSW
- Be a current member of NSWISA of not less than two years
- Must have competed at NSWISA sanctioned event in the past 12 months
- Be able to demonstrate commitment and desire to develop to a National and/or International standard of competition
- Previous successful scholarship holder of 1st Tier Scholarship may not reapply for a period of two years (ie 2019 winner may not reapply in 2020 or 2021).

YOU MAY SKATE ANY DISCIPLINE BUT,

- Single, Dance and Pair Skaters must be at an IJS recognised division
- Synchronized skaters must have represented NSW at a National Championship or competed in an International event.

ABOUT

The Alan Blinn and Simone Moore Memorial Fund has been established by the NSWISA to honour their memory. Both died tragically on Sydney Harbour 28th March, 2007.

Both Alan and Simone shared a passion for skating and contributed hugely not only to skating in Australia, but to skating around the world. Alan was an international judge, and President of NSWISA. Simone, an ISU Championship Judge and International Referee, had been newly appointed to the NSWISA council. Their legacy will be to assist future generations of aspiring skaters to further develop their talent and follow their sporting careers so that they may achieve their full potential.

WHAT IS AVAILABLE?

- All scholarships will be gender neutral
- A total of \$6000 will be awarded with 1 major scholarship awarded to a skater with **Advanced Novice - Senior levels** - the number of scholarship awards and the amount of each individual scholarship may vary at the discretion of the Awards committee.

HOW WILL MY APPLICATION BE ASSESSED?

The information supplied in the completed application forms will be made available to the NSWISA appointed selection committee. The decision will be final, no correspondence will be entered into.

Presentation of the Scholarships will take place at NSW Figure Skating Championships.
