### **1. Purpose of the Policy**

This Policy establishes the criteria for entry to all competitions and events held by NSWISA or its Affiliated Clubs.

### **2. Application of the Policy**

This Policy applies to all eligible NSWISA Members and Guests of other State Associations and ISU Members. This Policy applies to all divisions and activities forming part of the events held.

### **3. Entries**

All entries for all events must be made using the NSWISA online registration system available at [www.nswisa.com](http://www.nswisa.com) and must be completed in full to be deemed complete. This includes the submission of music and PPCs where relevant as well as payment. Any incomplete entries may be rejected.

No late entries will be accepted.

Members of the host Club will be given priority if there are too many entrants for the ice time available. This priority policy will operate across all divisions.

Members of Novelty Groups and TOI Teams participating in Artistic Competitions may be replaced in the case of illness or injury if a medical certificate or other formal medical evidence is provided prior to the competition. Replacement skaters must meet all eligibility criteria and register using the online registration system to enter the competition as a member of the Novelty Group or TOI Team. The maximum number of skaters to skate in each Novelty Group or TOI Team is determined at the close of entries by the number of members registered to the team. The number of skaters cannot be increased after the close of entries. Skaters who can not compete in the Novelty Group or TOI Team on medical grounds will be withdrawn from the Novelty Group or TOI Team and the replacement skater(s) will take their place in the Novelty Group or TOI Team. If the Novelty Group or TOI Team need to compete with fewer than the number of skaters originally entered as part of the team as at close of entries, they will compete in the division in which they originally

entered, even if the number of skaters participating in the competition would make them eligible for a different division.
