## NSWISA ENTRY TO STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS POLICY

of

### THE NEW SOUTH WALES ICE SKATING ASSOCIATION INCORPORATED

#### 1. Purpose of the Policy

This Policy establishes the criteria for entry to the annual NSWISA State Championships or the NSWISA Adult State Championships. The Policy outlines the eligibility of all skaters intending to participate in either Championships, both NSWISA Members and Guests. The NSWISA Artistic Championship event will be the State Championship event for Theatre on Ice (TOI).

#### 2. Application of the Policy

This Policy applies to all eligible NSWISA Members and Guests of other State Associations and ISU Members. This Policy applies to all divisions forming part of each Championship.

#### 3. Eligibility

To be eligible to enter the NSWISA State Championships or the NSWISA Adult State Championships, competitors must meet the following criteria:

##### **SINGLES, PAIRS & ICE DANCE:**

- Each skater must be a financial Member of NSWISA or another State Association or ISU Member and a home Club
- Each skater must hold the relevant ISA test level to compete as per the relevant ISA By-Laws
- For NSWISA Members, each skater must have competed in at least one IJS technical event in the twelve (12) months prior to the Championship. This competition must be a NSW competition or an ISA Event in any State or an International Event.
- Competition. For Guests, entries must be approved by the skater's/skaters
- Association/Member and will be approved by the Championship Organising Committee after consideration

In cases of exceptional circumstances where skaters are not able to meet the above criteria, applications may be made to the NSWISA Board and Championship Organising Committee for review. Supporting documentation may be required.

##### **SYNCHRONIZED SKATING:**

- Team Members must be financial Members of NSWISA or another State Association or ISU Member and a home Club
- Teams must meet the ISA requirements for Team Composition as per ISA By-Laws Section 10
- For NSWISA Members, teams must have competed in at least one SYS IJS event in event in the twelve (12) months prior to the Championship.

- For Guests, entries must be approved by the team's Association/Member and will be approved by the Championship Organising Committee after consideration

In cases of exceptional circumstances where teams are not able to meet the above criteria, applications may be made to the NSWISA Board and Championships Organising Committee for review. Supporting documentation may be required.

#### 4. Eligibility to enter the NSWISA Artistic and the Theatre On Ice Championship

To be eligible to enter the NSWISA Artistic and NSWISA Theatre On Ice State Championships, competitors must meet the following criteria:

- All skaters must be financial Members of NSWISA or another State Association or ISU Member and a home Club
- TOI Teams must meet the ISA requirements for Team Composition as per ISA By-Laws Section 12
- For NSWISA Members, teams must have competed in at least one Artistic or TOI event in the twelve (12) months prior to the Championship.
- For Guests, entries must be approved by the team's Association/Member and will be approved by the Championship Organising Committee after consideration

In cases of exceptional circumstances where teams are not able to meet the above criteria, applications may be made to the NSWISA Board and Championships Organising Committee for review. Supporting documentation may be required.

#### 5. Entries

Entries to all events must be made using the NSWISA online registration system available at [www.nswisa.com](http://www.nswisa.com). PPC(s), music and payment must all be submitted at the time of entry for the entry to be accepted.
