NSWISA OFFICIALS FUNDING POLICY

of

THE NEW SOUTH WALES ICE SKATING ASSOCIATION INCORPORATED

1. Purpose of the Policy

This Policy establishes the criteria for funding for NSWISA Officials. The Policy outlines the eligibility for funding of all persons officiating at NSWISA Affiliated Club, NSWISA, ISA or ISU events.

2. Application of the Policy

This Policy applies to all eligible NSWISA Members who Officiate at events. This Policy applies to all events run in each calendar year by NSWISA Affiliated Clubs NSWISA, ISA or ISU. Members will be considered as Officiating if they act as a:

- Referee
- Judge
- Trial Judge
- Technical Controller
- Technical Specialist
- Data Entry Operator
- Video Replay Operator
- Accountant
- IJS Support Personnel

3. Eligibility

To be eligible for funding from NSWISA Officials must:

- Be a current financial Member of NSWISA
- For funding for National Championships, International Competitions, ISU Seminars and ISU Exams, officials must have officiated at a minimum of three (3) events within NSW in the year of the event and completed the online NSWISA Jot form at the conclusion of the event. This can be found on the NSWISA website.
- For International Competitions, ISU Seminars and ISU Exams, officials should make an application for approval of the funding from NSWISA before the event.

4. Funding

<i>NSWISA Aussie Skate Competitions</i>	\$35 per session if in Area of Residence \$100 per session if outside Area of Residence
<i>NSW Competitions & Championships</i>	\$100 per day for officials not coaching on the day if in Area of Residence.^~ \$175 per day for officials not coaching on the day if outside Area of Residence.^~ \$35 per day for officials coaching on the day that they are assisting on the panel as well. ^~
<i>IJS Event Set Up – Data or Music</i>	An additional \$110 per event
<i>Australian Figure Skating Championships (AFSC)</i> <i>Australian Adult Figure Skating Championships (AAFSC)</i>	\$175 per day for officials not coaching on the day if AFSC/AAFSC held outside NSW or outside the Area of Residence^~ \$50 per day for officials coaching on the day that they are assisting on the panel as well if AFSC/AAFSC held outside NSW or outside the Area of Residence. ^~ \$50 per day for officials not coaching on the day for events held in the Area of Residence ^~ \$35 per day for officials coaching on the day that they are assisting on the panel on the day for events held in the Area of Residence ^~
<i>NSWISA approved Seminars</i>	<u>Training Seminars approved by NSWISA</u> \$175 per day for officials who are presenting and are not coaching on the day \$100 per day for officials who are attending and are not coaching on the day Online Seminars Approved by NSWISA \$35 per officials
<i>ISU Seminars (not held in conjunction with AFSC and only when a seminar has not been offered in Australia within 48 months for the respective discipline and a seminar is held in NSW for local Officials)</i>	\$35 per day per seminar if held in NSW Area of Residence \$150 per day per seminar if held in NSW but Outside Area of Residence \$330 per seminar if held in Australia but not NSW Up to \$1,100 per seminar if held overseas*
<i>ISU Examinations</i>	Up to \$1,100 per exam if passed*
<i>International Competitions</i>	\$300 per event ***

^Officials coaching on the day receive remuneration from students to cover out of pocket expenses for the event. Coaches not coaching on the day are eligible for full funding for that day.

~ Panelled Officials only, taken by days officiating on panels for events held in NSW and by days available to be panelled for events held outside NSW.

** Funding only available if travel & board is not fully covered by ISU, ISA or other parties. If other funding is received, the available funding from NSWISA is only to the value of any expenses that are not already covered. Only one payment is applicable for a combined seminar & exam.*

****Funding only available to ISA approved competitions listed on their website.*

5. NSW Areas

Funding is based on the postcode of the NSWISA Officials Area of Residence in relation to the Rink/Venue's Area. NSW will be split into Areas according to the following table.

For NSWISA officials residing outside NSW the Area of Residence will be classed as Sydney Metropolitan Area for NSW events.

**Residential Areas North/South of the Sydney Metropolitan Area will be assessed when venue is outside Sydney Metropolitan area*

6. Payment

Payments will be made biannually in January and in August each year.

Any changes made to this Policy or resulting payments will be at the discretion of the Board.
