1. Purpose of the Policy

This Policy communicates the Covid-safe practices that will be employed in relation to IJS events and equipment at all events held in NSW.

2. Application of the Policy

This Policy applies to all events held in NSW which make use of the NSWISA IJS.

3. Policy

All Clubs are to provide platforms, desks and seating which ensures all officials which need to be seated on the panel are distanced with at least 1.5m between each person. The platforms and desks must be set up at least 90 minutes prior to the scheduled commencement of the event.

Each Club will need to provide one volunteer for the duration of the event who will be responsible for disinfecting the IJS equipment before, during and after the competition. All equipment is to be wiped down after the set up is completed by the NSWISA IJS Tech Team according to the instructions provided and before officials take their seats prior to the commencement of the event. Equipment is to be wiped down at each change in panel, as well as at any change in personnel at both the video camera and announcer stations. Immediately after the officials leave the panel at the conclusion of the event, all equipment is to be wiped down so it can be packed away.

Officials should maintain social distancing at all times and should take their place on the panel only when instructed to do so.

Blankets and other warming devices should not be shared by officials. Items such as these should be allocated to each individual for use during the event.

Individual headsets or ear and microphone covers will be provided to each member of the Technical Panel to be used during the event. This may vary from event to event.



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Panels will be designed so there is no unnecessary movement during the event. Where judges change judge numbers, there won't be movement on the panel, the changes will be made on the computers only unless it is not possible to achieve the required change in this way. Where there are needs to change TSs, including when the people stay the same but the TS & ATS roles change, this will be a change of function, but the individuals involved won't change seats on the panel.

Individual hand sanitiser packs will be provided for each official position and should not be removed from the panel until final pack up of all equipment by the NSWISA IJS Tech Team.
