Membership Requirements	At close of entries, all Australian competitors <b>must</b> be a full financial member of their relevant State Association and an Affiliated Club, (inclusive of ISA Insurance Registration either directly or via their State Association).  The membership must be valid during the full competition period.  All Aussie Skate™ entrants must also be registered with ISA Aussie Skate™  Overseas entrants must be financial members of an ISU Member skating organization and/or its affiliates, as required by their national organization. The membership must be valid during the full competition period. Skaters are required to submit a letter of clearance to skate from their Member Federation.		
Eligibility to Compete	Skaters Preliminary and above must have passed the relevant ISA test level at the close of entries.  Teams must meet the ISA requirements for Team Composition.  Competitors in Aussie Skate™ divisions must compete at the highest test level passed by the competition closing date and cannot enter a level lower than that which they have previously competed. Aussie Skate refer: ISA Communication 101.
