Eligibility to Compete	All competitors must meet the entry requirements stipulated in the NSWISA Entry To State Artistic Championships Policy. Skaters Preliminary and above must have passed the relevant ISA test level at the close of entries. Teams must meet the ISA requirements for Team Composition. Competitors in Aussie Skate™ divisions must compete at the highest test level passed by the competition closing date and cannot enter a level lower than that which they have previously competed.
