Team Numbers	Minimum of 8, Maximum of 24 skaters
Judges	Judges are by invitation and should register using the NSWISA online registration process.
Membership Requirements	At close of entries, all Australian competitors must be a full financial member of their relevant State Association and an Affiliated Club. (Inclusive of ISA Insurance Registration either directly or via their State Association). The membership must be valid during the full competition period.

This policy includes Sport Accident cover.</p> <p>ISA, NSWISA & SIT assume no responsibility for other persons in connection with this event.</p> <p>ISA recommends that any person travelling to an interstate event consider personal travel insurance.</p> <p>Risk Management: Each OC must assess each event against the guidelines outlined in the ISA 14 – Risk Management Policies and Protocols Manual 2018 - http://www.isa.org.au/policies-and-protocols.</p>
Warm Up Time	2 minutes. Props must be set up on the ice during this time.
Practice Sessions	No official practices will be offered.

Entry Process	<p>Online entry via the NSWISA website: > Info > Competitions > Sydney Theatre Cup.</p> <p>Please note the entry process requires all components to be complete or entry will not be accepted.</p> <p>The relevant State Association will ensure that all entrants are eligible to compete, and that membership status is current.</p>
Conditions for Online Entry	<p>All Interstate competitors must notify their relevant State Association of their entry submission prior to entering.</p> <p>All State Associations will be asked to confirm that entrants are full financial members in good standing, of both the State Association and an Affiliated Club.</p> <p>POAs – Proof of Age number must be provided upon online entry.</p>
Payment Process	Payable as part of the NSWISA online competition application process and no separate payments will be accepted.
Entry Conditions	<p>Entries will not be considered complete unless accompanied by:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Full Payment paid on competition registration ○ Music File - submitted online <u>by close of entries</u> ○ All entries must contain a written description of the Free Program. Description should be no longer than 50 words. <p>* Late entries will not be accepted.</p>

Other Music file notes	<p>All competitors must have on hand at the event, a backup copy of their competition music on CD or USB Drive, as specified.</p> <p>Each program must be recorded on a separate file and labelled with competitor division, name and running time of the music.</p> <p>The electronic playlist will be deleted at the end of the event. All music remains the property of the skater and will not be shared or re-used.</p>

Awards/Trophies	Trophies/Medals will be awarded to the first three teams in each division.

Photography can only be undertaken in the clearly marked designated area. NO PHOTOGRAPHY WILL BE PERMITTED AT ANY TIME WITHOUT A PERMIT.

VIDEOGRAPHY

Video Recording: Individuals using video cameras will be required to register at the Information/Registration desk on the day of the event. No lights on cameras are permitted while videoing.

Videoing can only be undertaken in the designated area.
