Eligibility to Compete	Previous winners of NSWISA Aussie Skate divisions may not re-enter the division won except where there were less than 3 entrants in that division but may enter a higher division even though they may not have yet passed the necessary test level. Skaters may not enter a division lower than that for which they have passed the test. Care must be taken that all competitors are entered in the correct divisions, as changes may not be allowed due to scheduling.
Insurance / Liability	All members of State Associations are covered under the ISA National Insurance Policy while participating in the event. This policy includes Sport Accident cover. ISA & NSWISA assume no responsibility for other persons in connection with this event. ISA recommends that any person travelling to an interstate event consider personal travel insurance.
