The membership must be valid during the full competition period. Skaters are required to submit a letter of clearance to skate from their Member Federation.

They may ONLY video the skater that has been authorized on the registration form.</p> <p>Videoing can only be undertaken in the designated area.</p> <p>Anyone caught filming a skater without permission will be required to delete the footage immediately when requested to do so by a competition official</p> <p><b>VIDEOING OF WARM-UPS IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED.</b></p> <p><b>No lights on cameras are permitted while videoing.</b></p>
