<b>Event Officials</b>	Referees, Judges, Technical Controllers, Technical Specialists, Data Operators & Video Replay Operators for all scheduled events are by invitation and Officials should register via the Assemble Sports Registration Platform with the link provided.
<b>Membership Requirements</b>	<p>At close of entries, all Australian competitors <b>must</b> be a full financial member of their relevant State Association and an Affiliated Club, (inclusive of ISA Insurance Registration either directly or via their State Association).</p> <p>The membership must be valid during the full competition period.</p> <p>Overseas entrants must be financial members of an ISU Member skating organization and/or its affiliates, as required by their national organization. The membership must be valid during the full competition period. Skaters are required to submit a letter of clearance to skate from their Member Federation.</p>

<b>Insurance / Liability</b>	<p>All members of State Associations are covered under the ISA National Insurance Policy while participating in the event. <b>Conditions for Online Entries</b>	<p>Entries will be via the NSWISA online entry system.</p> <p>All interstate competitors must notify their relevant State Association of their entry submission <b>prior</b> to entering.</p> <p>All State Associations will be asked to confirm that entrants are full financial members in good standing of both the State Association and an Affiliated Club and are eligible to compete.</p>
<b>Payment Process</b>	Online payment at time of the entry.
<b>Entry Conditions, Payment Process and Eligibility to Compete</b>	<p>Entries will not be considered complete unless accompanied by:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All competitor details</li> <li>• Full payment on entry</li> <li>• Music and Planned Program Content (PPC) file(s) submitted as per NSWISA Music &amp; PPC Submission Policy</li> <li>• <b>LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED</b> (as per the NSWISA Entry to Competitions &amp; Championships Policy)</li> </ul>
<b>Withdrawals</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Email <a href="mailto:nswisa@nswisa.com">nswisa@nswisa.com</a> to notify of your withdrawal</li> <li>• Refund only with a medical certificate provided <b>before the draw</b></li> <li>• Prior to the draw 20% of the entry fee will be deducted from the refund</li> <li>• Transaction Fees will not be refunded</li> <li>• <b>No refund permitted after the draw</b></li> <li>• The Music &amp; PPC upload fees and any late fees will not be refunded in case of withdrawal</li> </ul>

<b>Other Music File Notes</b>	<p>All competitors must have on hand at the event, a backup copy of their competition music on USB Drive (or other device as permitted).</p> <p><b>Music (ISU Rule 343 Singles, Pairs &amp; Ice Dance and ISU Rule 823 SYS): Please note paragraphs 1a), 1b), 1c), 2, 3, 4, re: Music Reproduction.</b></p> <p>Each program must be recorded on a separate file and labelled with competitor division, name and running time of the music.</p> <p>The electronic playlist will be deleted at the end of the event. All music remains the property of the skater and will not be shared or re-used.</p>

<b>Awards/Trophies</b>	<p>Medals/Trophies will be awarded to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> places in each division.</p> <p><b>LCCISC Club Champion</b> trophies will be awarded at the 2022 LCCISC Annual Presentation. Aussie Skate Club Champions will be determined at the <u>NSWISA run</u> Aussie Skate Competition on Saturday 22<sup>nd</sup> October. The IJS level Club Champions, including Adults, will be determined at this event.</p>

<b>OFFICIAL EVENT PHOTOGRAPHY/VIDEOGRAPHY</b>	
<b>Photography</b>	<b>Videography</b>
<p>An official photographer will be taking photos at the competition. Photos will be available for viewing and purchase.</p> <p>All private photographers are required to register at the Information/Registration Desk on the day of the event. They may ONLY photograph the skater that has been authorized on the registration form.</p> <p>Anyone caught photographing a skater without permission will be required to delete the images immediately when requested to do so by a competition official.</p> <p><b>No flash photography</b> is permitted in warm-ups or events, as it may be dangerous to the skaters.</p>	<p>Individuals recording video will be required to register at the Information/Registration desk on the day of the event. They may ONLY video the skater that has been authorized on the registration form.</p> <p>Videoring can only be undertaken in the designated area.</p> <p>Anyone caught recording a skater without permission will be required to delete the footage immediately when requested to do so by a competition official.</p> <p><b>VIDEOING OF WARM-UPS IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED.</b></p> <p><b>No lights on cameras are permitted while videoing.</b></p>
