



2023 SYDNEY SYNCHRONIZED FESTIVAL

PRESENTATION INFORMATION

Presentations at the 2023 Sydney Synchronized Festival will follow the ISU SYS Championship procedure as outlined in ISU Rule 871. An overview of this process is as follows:

1. For each Division, the Teams who place will be called to the podium in the following order:
 - ☆ 3rd Place Captains & Team
 - ☆ 2nd Place Captains & Team
 - ☆ 1st Place Captains & Team
2. Team Members line up in two lines behind the Team position on the podium, ie. six rows of skaters lined up behind podium for 1st, 2nd & 3rd placed Teams only.
Photo: The three Team Captains for 1st, 2nd & 3rd with the Team Members lined up behind their Captains.
3. This process will continue for each of the divisions to be awarded each day. Medals will be presented for the final overall place in each division only.

At the conclusion of the presentations, all Teams will be offered the opportunity to take photos, time permitting. 30 minutes has been allocated to presentations and photos each day so the cooperation of Teams during the presentations will result in more time being available for photos.

All Teams will be allocated an on-ice marshal to assist with the smooth running of the presentations. All Teams participating in the presentations are asked to enter the ice immediately after the marks have been announced for the final Team of each day and will be required to exit the ice at the specified time for the conclusion of their presentation.

We ask for your assistance with explaining this procedure to your Team to ensure the flow of the presentations is maintained and the time available for Teams to take photos on ice is maximised.
