<b>Results</b>	The IJS (ISU Judging System) will be used for all IJS Divisions. Results displayed or announced will remain provisional until the results are certified by the segment Referee and Technical Controller on the official result form.
<b>Event Officials</b>	Event officials for the panels are arranged by the Chair, ISA Judges and Officials.
<b>Membership Requirements</b>	At close of entries, all Australian competitors must be a full financial member of their relevant ISA Member and an Affiliated Club (if a Club Membership is a requirement of their ISA Member) which will be inclusive of ISA Insurance Registration. The membership must be valid during the full competition period.

<p><b>Eligibility to Compete</b></p>	<p>Athletes are to be nominated by their ISA Member for entry to AFSC 2023. Skaters must have passed the relevant ISA test level at close of entries and meet the ISA AFSC qualification scores detailed in ISA Communications 147 &amp; 148. Teams must meet the ISA requirements for Team Composition.</p>
<p><b>Practice Sessions</b></p>	<p>Official practices will be offered as per the event schedule. Unofficial practices will also be offered as time permits after close of entries.</p>
<p><b>Live Streaming</b></p>	<p>The competition will be live-streamed and available on the NSWISA YouTube Channel.</p>

**COMPETITION ENTRY DETAILS**

<p><b>Conditions for Online Entries</b></p>	<p>Entries will be via the NSWISA online entry system.</p> <p>All ISA Members will be asked to confirm that entrants are full financial members in good standing. As per ISA Communication 147 they will also be asked to confirm that the skater has achieved the required TES and the event(s) in which they gained the score(s).</p>
<p><b>Payment Process</b></p>	<p>Online payment required at time of the entry.</p>
<p><b>Entry Conditions, Payment Process and Eligibility to Compete</b></p>	<p>Entries will not be considered complete unless accompanied by:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All competitor details</li> <li>• Full payment on entry</li> <li>• Music and Planned Program Content (PPC) file(s) submitted as per NSWISA Music &amp; PPC Submission Policy</li> <li>• Passport size photo identification</li> <li>• <b>LATE ENTRIES MAY NOT BE ACCEPTED, but if they are, an additional fee of \$100 will be payable</b></li> </ul>
<p><b>Withdrawals</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Register your withdrawal using this <a href="#">link</a>, you will be required to upload a medical certificate if the withdrawal occurs before the draw and a refund is required</li> <li>• Refund only with a medical certificate provided <b>before the draw</b></li> <li>• Prior to the draw 25% of the entry fee will be deducted from the refund</li> <li>• Transaction Fees will not be refunded</li> <li>• <b>No refund permitted after the draw</b></li> <li>• The music and PPC upload fees and any late fees will not be refunded in case of withdrawal</li> </ul>

<p><b>Other Music File Notes</b></p>	<p>All competitors must have on hand at the event, a backup copy of their competition music on USB Drive.</p> <p><b>Music (ISU Rule 343 Singles, Pairs &amp; Dance and ISU Rule 823 SYS): Please note paragraphs 1a), 1b), 1c), 2, 3, 4, re: Music Reproduction.</b></p> <p>Each program must be recorded as a separate file and labelled with competitor division, name and running time of the music.</p> <p>The electronic playlist will be deleted at the end of the event. All music remains the property of the skater and will not be shared or re-used.</p>
<p><b>Schedule</b></p>	<p>A schedule of events will be provided following the close of entries and published on the NSWISA website <a href="http://www.nswisa.com">www.nswisa.com</a>.</p>
<p><b>Awards / Trophies</b></p>	<p>Medals/Trophies will be awarded to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> places in each division.</p> <p>Perpetual Trophies will be presented where applicable.</p>
<p><b>Coach Accreditation</b></p>	<p>Only coaches who present APSA photo accreditation to the Registration Desk may obtain Championship accreditation. No unaccredited Coaches or other support personnel of any description will be allowed rink-side during practice sessions or events. In the case of an international coach, the coach may make written application to APSA seeking endorsement for the provision of championship accreditation upon review of evidence of qualifications submitted in English.</p> <p>Coaches may not access the judging stand at any time during practices or events.</p>
<p><b>Team Manager &amp; Chaperone Accreditation</b></p>	<p>Accreditation will be provided to one Chaperone per Singles, Pairs &amp; Ice Dance competitor. One Team Manager and one Chaperone pass will be provided per Synchronized Team.</p>

**OFFICIAL EVENT PHOTOGRAPHY/VIDEOGRAPHY**

<b>Photography</b>	<b>Videography</b>
<p>An official photographer will be taking photos at the competition. Photos will be available for viewing and purchase.</p> <p>All private photographers are required to register at the Information/Registration Desk on the day of the event. They may ONLY photograph the skater that has been authorized on the registration form.</p> <p>Anyone caught photographing a skater without permission will be required to delete the images immediately when requested to do so by a competition official.</p> <p><b>No flash photography</b> is permitted in warm-ups or events, as it may be dangerous to the skaters.</p>	<p>Individuals recording video will be required to register at the Information/Registration desk on the day of the event. They may ONLY video the skater that has been authorized on the registration form.</p> <p>Videoing can only be undertaken in the designated area.</p> <p>Anyone caught recording a skater without permission will be required to delete the footage immediately when requested to do so by a competition official.</p> <p><b>VIDEOING OF PRACTICE SESSIONS AND WARM-UPS IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED. No lights on cameras are permitted while videoing.</b></p>



## BANQUET INFORMATION

Entry to both Championship Banquets will be by ticket only at a ticket price of \$75 per person.

The Synchronized Skating Banquet:

- The banquet will be held on the evening of Sunday 3<sup>rd</sup> December at Mingara Recreation Club from 7:00pm to 11:00pm.
- Synchronized competitors' entry is included in their entry fee; only 1 ticket will be issued per skater regardless of how many synchronized events they compete in.
- Synchronized skaters who double team or triple team will pay entry fee less \$75.
- Absolutely NO correspondence or discussion will be entertained in this matter.

The Figure Skating Banquet:

- The banquet will be held on the evening of Friday 8<sup>th</sup> December at Mingara Recreation Club from 7:00pm to 11:00pm
- Singles, Pairs and Ice Dance competitors' entry is included in their entry fee; only one ticket will be issued per skater regardless of how many Figure Skating events they compete in.
- Skaters who skate in more than one Singles, Pairs or Ice Dance event will pay entry fee less \$75.
- Absolutely NO correspondence or discussion will be entertained in this matter.

All competitors are to confirm their attendance when registering for the Championship and must advise NSWISA Administration if their circumstances change and they are no longer able to attend a banquet.

All dietary requirements are to be advised either with the competition entry for all competitors or as part of the ticket purchase for all other attendees.

As the banquets will be held in a licenced club, all attendees 18 years and over will need to provide photo ID to sign into the venue and all minors must be accompanied by an adult. All competitors, Officials and volunteers will be required to produce their AFSC23 accreditation to enter the banquet(s).
