The membership must be valid during the full competition period. Skaters are required to submit a letter of clearance to skate from their Member Federation.

Music (ISU Rule 343 Singles, Pairs & Dance and ISU Rule 823 SYS): Please note paragraphs 1a), 1b), 1c), 2, 3, 4, re: Music Reproduction.  Each program must be recorded as a separate file and labelled with competitor division, name and running time of the music.  The electronic playlist will be deleted at the end of the event. All music remains the property of the skater and will not be shared or re-used.

Photography	Videography				
An official photographer will be taking photos at the competition. Photos will be available for viewing and purchase.  All private photographers are required to register at the Information/Registration Desk on the day of the event. They may ONLY photograph the skater that has been authorized on the registration form.  Anyone caught photographing a skater without permission will be required to delete the images immediately when requested to do so by a competition official.  No flash photography is permitted in warm-ups or events, as it may be dangerous to the skaters.	Individuals recording video will be required to register at the Information/Registration desk on the day of the event. They may ONLY video the skater that has been authorized on the registration form.  Videoing can only be undertaken in the designated area.  Anyone caught recording a skater without permission will be required to delete the footage immediately when requested to do so by a competition official.  VIDEOING OF WARM-UPS IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED.  No lights on cameras are permitted while videoing.
