Overseas entrants must be financial members of an ISU Member skating organization and/or its affiliates, as required by their national organization. The membership must be valid during the full competition period. Skaters are required to submit a letter of clearance to skate from their Member Federation.

Music (ISU Rule 343 Singles, Pairs & Dance and ISU Rule 823 SYS): Please note paragraphs 1a), 1b), 1c), 2, 3, 4, re: Music Reproduction. Each program must be recorded as a separate file and labelled with competitor division, name and running time of the music. The electronic playlist will be deleted at the end of the event. All music remains the property of the skater and will not be shared or re-used.

Awards / Trophies	Medals/Trophies will be awarded to 1 st , 2 nd and 3 rd places in each division. Hollins Trophy & Co-operative Cup, Carr's Cup and Dance Cup are perpetual trophies and will be awarded to 1st place in the senior divisions for Ladies and Men's Singles, Pairs and Dance Couples only. All perpetual trophies will be retained by the Sydney Figure Skating Club and will be engraved with the name of the winner(s).

An official photographer will be taking photos at the competition. Photos will be available for viewing and purchase. VIDEOING OF WARM-UPS IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED. No lights on cameras are permitted while videoing.			
All private photographers are required to register at the Information/Registration Desk on the day of the event. They may ONLY photograph the skater that has been authorized on the registration form.				
Anyone caught photographing a skater without permission will be required to delete the images immediately when requested to do so by a competition official.				
No flash photography is permitted in warm-ups or events, as it may be dangerous to the skaters.
