Practice Sessions	Official practices will not be offered for this event.

Membership Requirements	At close of entries, all Australian competitors must be a full financial member of their relevant ISA Member and an Affiliated Club, (inclusive of ISA Insurance Registration either directly or via their ISA Member). The membership must be valid during the full competition period. All Aussie Skate™ entrants must also be registered with ISA Aussie Skate™. Overseas entrants must be financial members of an ISU Member skating organization and/or its affiliates, as required by their national organization. The membership must be valid during the full competition period. Skaters are required to submit a letter of clearance to skate from their Member Federation.
Insurance / Liability	All members of ISA Members are covered under the ISA National Insurance Policy while participating in the event. This policy includes Sport Accident cover. ISA, NSWISA & LCCISC assume no responsibility for other persons in connection with this event. ISA recommends that any person travelling to an interstate event consider personal travel insurance. Eligibility to Compete	Skaters Preliminary and above must have passed the relevant ISA test level at close of entries. Competitors in Aussie Skate™ categories must compete at the highest test level passed by the competition closing date and cannot enter a level lower than that which they have previously competed. ISA Communication 101.

Conditions for Online Entries	Entries will be via the NSWISA online entry system. All interstate competitors must notify their relevant ISA Member of their entry submission prior to entering. All ISA Members will be asked to confirm that entrants are full financial members in good standing of both the ISA Member and an Affiliated Club and are eligible to compete.
Payment Process	Online payment at time of the entry.
Entry Conditions, Payment Process and Eligibility to Compete	Entries will not be considered complete unless accompanied by: • All competitor details • Full payment on entry • Music file(s) submitted as per NSWISA Music & PPC Submission Policy • LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED (as per the NSWISA Entry to Competitions & Championships Policy)
Withdrawals	• Register your withdrawal using this link, you will be required to upload a medical certificate if the withdrawal occurs before the draw and a refund is required • Refund only with a medical certificate provided before the draw • Prior to the draw 25% of the entry fee will be deducted from the refund • Transaction Fees will not be refunded • No refund permitted after the draw • The Music upload fees and any late fees will not be refunded in case of withdrawal

Other Music File Notes	All competitors must have on hand at the event, a backup copy of their competition music on USB Drive (or other device as permitted). Music (ISU Rule 343 Singles, Pairs & Ice Dance and ISU Rule 823 SYS): Please note paragraphs 1a), 1b), 1c), 2, 3, 4, re: Music Reproduction. Each program must be recorded on a separate file and labelled with competitor category, name and running time of the music. The electronic playlist will be deleted at the end of the event. All music remains the property of the skater and will not be shared or re-used.
Schedule	A schedule of events will be provided following the closing of entries and published on the NSWISA website www.nswisa.com.
Awards / Trophies	Medals/Trophies will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd places in each category. Pam Kavanagh Artistic Trophy: In honour of the late LCCISC Coach, Pam Kavanagh, this trophy will be awarded for the most artistic routine. The recipient of the Pam Kavanagh Artistic Trophy will be selected by the judging panel.

OFFICIAL EVENT PHOTOGRAPHY/VIDEOGRAPHY	
Photography	Videography
An official photographer will be taking photos at the competition. Photos will be available for viewing and purchase. All private photographers are required to register at the Information/Registration Desk on the day of the event. They may ONLY photograph the skater that has been authorized on the registration form. Anyone caught photographing a skater without permission will be required to delete the images immediately when requested to do so by a competition official. No flash photography is permitted in warm-ups or events, as it may be dangerous to the skaters.	Individuals recording video will be required to register at the Information/Registration desk on the day of the event. They may ONLY video the skater that has been authorized on the registration form. Videoing can only be undertaken in the designated area. Anyone caught recording a skater without permission will be required to delete the footage immediately when requested to do so by a competition official. VIDEOING OF WARM-UPS IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED. No lights on cameras are permitted while videoing.
