Membership Requirements	<p>At close of entries, all Australian competitors must be a full financial member of their relevant State Association and an Affiliated Club, (inclusive of ISA Insurance Registration either directly or via their State Association).</p> <p>The membership must be valid during the full competition period.</p> <p>All Aussie Skate™ entrants must also be registered with ISA Aussie Skate™.</p> <p>Overseas entrants must be financial members of an ISU Member skating organization and/or its affiliates, as required by their national organization. The membership must be valid during the full competition period. Skaters are required to submit a letter of clearance to skate from their Member Federation.</p>
Insurance / Liability	<p>All members of State Associations are covered under the ISA National Insurance Policy while participating in the event. Withdrawals	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Register your withdrawal using this link, you will be required to upload a medical certificate if the withdrawal occurs before the draw and a refund is required • Refund only with a medical certificate provided before the draw • Prior to the draw 25% of the entry fee will be deducted from the refund • Transaction Fees will not be refunded • No refund permitted after the draw • The Music upload fees and any late fees will not be refunded in case of withdrawal

Other Music File Notes	<p>All competitors must have on hand at the event, a backup copy of their competition music on USB Drive (or other device as permitted).</p> <p>Music (ISU Rule 343 Singles, Pairs & Ice Dance and ISU Rule 823 SYS): Please note paragraphs 1a), 1b), 1c), 2, 3, 4, re: Music Reproduction.</p> <p>Each program must be recorded on a separate file and labelled with competitor division, name and running time of the music.</p> <p>The electronic playlist will be deleted at the end of the event. All music remains the property of the skater and will not be shared or re-used.</p>

They may ONLY video the skater that has been authorized on the registration form.</p> <p>Videoing can only be undertaken in the designated area.</p> <p>Anyone caught recording a skater without permission will be required to delete the footage immediately when requested to do so by a competition official.</p> <p>VIDEOING OF WARM-UPS IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED.</p> <p>No lights on cameras are permitted while videoing.</p>
